We relaunched 15 months ago with the initial aim of raising enough money to pay for three major school projects: an all-weather canopy for the playground, drainage for the sports field and new toilet blocks. Here's a reminder of what we've achieved over the past three terms

- We've held five fabulous social events, including the Centenary Ball.
- Our volunteers have set up and run a much-appreciated refreshments service during the school's music, dance and drama performances.
- PTA mums Kes and Lucy have set up and run a preloved uniform initiative that has spared 297 items from going to landfill, saved parents thousands of pounds and is an inspirational example of the circular economy in practice.
- We've supplied and built two greenhouses and a shed in the quad for the science department.
- We have sourced and delivered thousands of pounds worth of office furniture for various areas around the school and donated computer equipment to bolster classroom provision.
- We've bought dozens of books for each form to support reading in the classroom.
- And last month, the school took delivery of a new drum kit purchased by the PTA for the music department.
